8.HIGHWAYS/PATHS/DYKES

- When the digging of the large dykes, across the land from Far Drain (Bishopsoil) to link with the new pumping station in Blacktoft, takes place will there be a contingency plan for the reduction of mud and disruption?
- Road closure Oxmaryke and dyke digging be timed to be at the same time?

The Clerk to contact the drainage board, NETWORK RAIL and the ERY Council.

For information: The Clerk has obtained this information from the relevant authorities:

- It is illegal to park any vehicle at all on a bridleway
- It is illegal to park any vehicle at all on a public footpath
- Associated British Ports (ABP) own Smithy Lane in Blacktoft and have confirmed to the Clerk that residents have been informed that no vehicles can be parked on the public footpath along Smithy Lane and the lane has to be kept free at all times for emergency and maintenance vehicles accessing the river bank
- The police have informed the Clerk that no vehicles can be parked on Smithy Lane – leaving the access free for emergency and maintenance vehicles
- Members of the public are encouraged to contact the police on 101 and ABP if a vehicle is parked on Smithy Lane, Blacktoft

- The riverbank is the responsibility of the Environment Agency with ERYC taking the responsibility for the public footpath.
 - The bungalows on Blacktoft Lane are owned by the ERY Council. If any member of the public has any issues regarding the parking of vehicles either on these properties or in the layby then they are encouraged to contact the police on 101 and the ERYC Housing Department
 - The encroachment and kerbing on Blacktoft Lane is being monitored by the ERYC. Whether or not the encroachment and kerbing is allowed to remain will be the decision of the ERYC.
 - Members of the public with issues regarding the encroachment of the highway and the placement of kerbing are again encouraged to contact the ERYC highways or enforcement officers.
