For information – sometime ago I queried with ERNLLCA the use of drones by parish councils for security re farm land etc. The response was slow and not very informative BUT – “Upper Slaughter as one of the quietest, most beautiful unspoilt villages within the Cotswold (with only 146 people on the electoral roll) now has to look at the use of drones differently. This area attracts many requests from filming companies to use the parish for filming – from BBC drama series to still photo shoots by fashion magazines. In the past the Cotswold District Council used to make the decision if a village or town could be used for filming purposes. Recently this decision has been delegated to the Clerk to the Parish (or Town) Council. The use of drones must be compliant to current legislation i.e. Air Navigation Order 2016. Larger and commercial drones have to be licensed and monitored by the Civil Aviation Authority. Permission of the landowner is required to take off and land the drone on their property and the drone cannot be flown directly over people, roads or without permission being given
